CSU FOUNDATION SCHOLARSHIPS: The following scholarships are being offered through the Connecticut State University System Foundation for students who been accepted to one of the universities in the CSU System for fall 2009.

Ted Martocchio Scholarship:

Criteria: GPA 2.75 minimum; leadership or examples of volunteer work, resident of Connecticut, accepted full time to any of the four universities (CCSU, ECSU, SCSU or WCSU) for Fall 2009, must be a child of Building and Trades Union Member. Financial need must be demonstrated.
